

Literary Scrapbook

You will be making a scrapbook of the novel that you read. Your scrapbook should be a good representation of the story, characters, and setting in the book. While reading, it would be a good idea to write down ideas or notes that you want to add to your scrapbook.

Your scrapbook **must have**:

- 📖 A cover with the title, author and an illustration pertaining to the book, but not copied. It should also have your name and date.
- 📖 A title page has a short description of the main characters and the settings in the book. You will also write a short summary of the book, which includes your opinion.
- 📖 The next 8 pages are your **content pages**. These pages demonstrate how you will represent your book. Each page should have a heading, be full of relevant information and colorful when appropriate. You can do more than 8 different representations of you book if you like.

Some ideas for content pages in your scrapbook include but are not limited to:

- 📖 Poems about or written from the point of view of your main character.
- 📖 Letters from one character to another.
- 📖 An autobiography about your main character.
- 📖 Drawings of characters and or scenes from the book. (Your drawings can be drawn to look like pictures that could have been taken by the characters.)
- 📖 Diary or journal entries written from the point of view of the main character, explaining important events in the book.
- 📖 An answer /question interview with the main character (s).
- 📖 Newspaper/magazine articles about the characters or events in the book.
- 📖 Any legal papers that might make sense to the book. (birth certificates, obituary, etc.)
- 📖 Write postcards from settings in the book, written from the perspective of the characters. (show both sides)
- 📖 A collection of souvenirs the main character may have collected (glued-on pictures or drawn).
- 📖 Maps of settings in the book.
- 📖 A guide explaining the book and its characters and settings.
- 📖 Draw or glue in pictures of specific items from the book that were important.

Your scrapbook should show good spelling and grammar, as well as, neatness, creativity and effort.
