

# Story Board

Many books have been made into movies. Examples include Beauty and the Beast and Alice in Wonderland. An important step in making a movie is creating a picture outline, which is called a storyboard.

## Directions:

1. Pick a scene from the book you read (A scene is whatever happens in one place). Your scene should be based on one of the main events of your story.
2. List each important action in the scene.
3. Divide a piece of paper into 6 or more boxes.
4. In the first box, draw the first action. Use only enough details to make the action clear. Then draw the following actions in your scene in order in the next boxes. (One action per box.)
5. Under each picture write a sentence that explains the action.
6. Make sure your Storyboard has the title of the book and the author on it.
7. On the back of your storyboard write a paragraph that has:
  - a. A short summary of the story.
  - b. Your opinion of the story.
  - c. Why you did or did not like it.
  - d. What was your favorite part?
  - e. Who was your favorite character?
  - f. If you would recommend it to others.
  - g. Would you read another book by this author?
